NARRATIVE:

Name: McNamara R

I was dispatched to 562 N. Market Blvd for a vehicle prowling in progress. Dispatch advised a white male wearing a blue plaid shirt and blue jeans is trying to get into her vehicle. The R/P is inside her vehicle and the male is banging on her windows.

When I arrived The R/P stepped out of her vehicle. She was crying and very upset. She said the male walked north on Market Blvd toward the theatre. I started walking that direction when a male in a silver car contacted me and said the person I was looking for just walked into The Trading Post.

I walked into The Trading Post and saw the suspect who I recognized as James Sauter from a picture I had recently seen of him. The manager of the store said he did not want Sauter in his business and wanted him trespassing.

Officers Bailey and Dozois contacted the R/P.

I contacted Sauter and told him I needed him to step outside and talk to me. I handcuffed Sauter, double locked the handcuffs and checked for proper fit. I asked Sauter to tell me what happened with the female in the vehicle. Sauter said nothing happened and he had done nothing that would get him arrested. Officer Bailey contacted me and said they had PC to arrest Sauter for Disorderly Conduct.

I told Sauter he was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and escorted him to my patrol vehicle. I also told Sauter he was trespassing from The Trading Post. I then searched Sauter incident to arrest. While searching Sauter I located a small black box in his left front pants pocket. I opened the box and saw pills inside it. In Sauter's right front coin pocket I found half of a pill. When Sauter saw the pill he said he had been looking for it.

I opened the back door to my vehicle and told Sauter to have a seat inside. Sauter started to get into my vehicle and then backed away saying he was not getting into the patrol car. Det Roberts and I grabbed Sauter and pushed him towards the doorway but he stiffened up and refused to get inside. With the assistance of Det Roberts and Officer Dozois we were able to push Sauter into the back seat. Once in the seat Sauter calmed down. I read Sauter his Miranda warnings from a card I was issued and he said he understood his rights. I asked him to tell me what really happened with the women in the car. Sauter said he had a bad feeling about two of the cars and the women inside of one of them. He said he may have touched the tire of the women's vehicle but he did not pound on or hit her vehicle. I asked Sauter what the pills were that I found in his pockets. He said they were his and it was none of my business what they were. I told Sauter that it was my business if they were prescription drugs and he did not have a prescription for them.

I gave the pills to Det. Roberts to identify and then I transported Sauter to the jail.

While I was at the jail Det. Roberts called me and said he was able to identify the pills. He said two of the pills were [REDACTED] which is a schedule 4 drug, one of them was [REDACTED] a schedule 5 drug and 1 the half pill were [REDACTED] which is an anti viral.

I asked Sauter what pill he had a prescription for. He said [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] I asked him what the other pill was that he had and he said he didn't know.

I then booked Sauter for 69.50.401, Possession of a controlled substance. I will refer Sauter for 9A.84.030, Disorderly Conduct.

All of the pills were placed into evidence to be sent to the lab for testing.

SUPPLEMENTAL/

While within the city limits of Chehalis on May 19th 2017 at 0915 hours I, Officer DOZOIS responded to a report of suspicious activity in the 500 Block of N Market Blvd.

The caller, Kysten TAGGART reported that a male was attempting to get into her vehicle near Pema Nails, located at 542 N Market Blvd.

I responded to the area and observed Sgt McNAMARA contacting a male, who I recognized as James SAUDER from previous contacts. Other officers were assisting Sgt McNAMARA, so I began speaking to witnesses in the area.

I spoke briefly to a female, who identified herself as Bobbie Jo WORLEY. She stated that she was sitting in front of Pema Nails, when she observed an older man demanding a second, younger man get back into his car. She stated that the older man was pointing his finger, but not touching anything. After the younger man got back into his car, the older man began tapping his finger on the younger man's windshield asking "whats that". WORLEY then called 911 and spoke to officers on scene.

She subsequently identified the male that Sgt McNAMARA arrested as the male she described in her statement.

I then spoke to a second female, who identified herself as Kysten TAGGART. She was visibly shaken and was crying. She stated that she was in her vehicle, waiting for Pema Nails to open for the day. She observed a white dodge (lic plate [REDACTED]) pull into a parking spot, stop, then back out and reversed approximately 1 block. She stated that he almost collided with a Honda that was honking at him. She then described that the white dodge parked again and a male exited the vehicle and walked over to her. The male told her that she needed to leave. TAGGART asked why and the male told her that she was "in his way". The male then put his hands in his pockets, so TAGGART rolled up her window. The male then kicked at her tires and began shaking the car. At this point she

called 911, as the male pushed at her windows and began to rock the car. TAGGART further described that the male looked at her the entire time she was on the phone. TAGGRT stated that she was scared and fearful for her life as the male was shaking the vehicle.

TAGGART also confirmed that the same male that Sgt McNAMARA arrested was the same male she described.

While I was still waiting on the above written statements, I heard Sgt McNAMARA request assistance to his location. I observed SAUDER in handcuffs, refusing to get into the back seat of Sgt McNAMARA's patrol vehicle. I entered the opposite side and assisted SAUDER into a seated position, without further incident. I then collected the above statements and left the area.

No further involvement.

I called Sergeant McNamarra at the jail and advised him of the findings.

I gave the pills to Sergeant McNamarra when he returned to the PD.

DECLARATION OF PROBABLE CAUSE

I was dispatched to I 562 N. Market Blvd for a vehicle prowl in progress. Dispatch advised a white male wearing a blue plaid shirt and blue jeans is trying to get into her vehicle. The R/p is inside her vehicle and the male is banging on her windows.

When I arrived The R/P stepped out of her vehicle. She was crying and very upset. She said the male walked north on Market Blvd toward the theatre. I started walking that direction when a male in a silver car contacted me and said the person I was looking for just walked into The Trading Post.

I walked into the trading post and saw the suspect who I recognized as James Sauter from a picture I had recently seen of him. The manager of the store said he did not want Suter in his business and wanted him trespassed.

Officers Bailey and Dozois contacted the R/P.

I contacted Sauter and told him I need him to step outside and talk to me. I handcuffed Suter, double locked the handcuffs and checked for proper fit. I asked Suter to tell me what happened with the female in the vehicle. Sauter said nothing happened and he had done nothing that would get him arrested.

Officer Bailey contacted me and said they had PC to arrest Sauter for Disorderly conduct.

I told Sauter he was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and escorted him to my patrol vehicle. I then searched Sauter incident to arrest. While searching Sauter I located a small black box in his left front pants pocket. I opened the box and saw pills inside it. In Sauter's right front coin pocket I found half of a pill. When Sauter saw the pill he said he had been looking for it.

I opened the back door to my vehicle and told Sauter to have a seat inside. Sauter started to get into my vehicle and then back away saying he was not getting into the patrol car. Det Roberts and I grabbed Sauter and pushed him towards the doorway but he stiffened up and refused to get inside. With the assistance of Det Roberts and Officer Dozois were we able to push Sauter into the back seat. Once in the seat Sauter calmed down. I read Sauter his Miranda warnings from a card I was issued and he said he understood his rights. I asked him to tell me what really happened with the women in the car. Sauter said he had a bad feeling about two of the cars and the women inside of one of them. He said he may have touched the tire of the women's vehicle but he did not pound on or hit her vehicle. I asked Sauter what the pill were that I fund in his pockets. He said they we his and it was none of my business what they were. I told Sauter that it was my business if they were prescription drugs and he did not have a prescription for them.

I gave the pills to Det. Roberts to identify and then I transported Sauter to the jail.

While I was at the jail Det. Roberts called me and said he was able to identify the pills. He said two of the pills were [REDACTED] which is a schedule 4 drug, one of them was [REDACTED] a schedule 5 drug and 1 the half pill were [REDACTED] which is an anti viral.

I asked Sauter what pill he had a prescription for. He said [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] I asked him what the other pill was that he had and he said he didn't know.

I then booked Sauter for 69.50.401, Possession of a controlled substance.
